

PhD Fellowship – History of the Genome

We are happy to invite applications **for a full-time PhD fellowship** to commence during Fall 2015. The successful candidate will work as part of the Israeli Science Foundation funded project "The History of the Genome: Introducing a Missing Actor in the Historiography of Genetics" led by Dr. Ehud Lamm (Tel Aviv University) and Prof. Oren Harman (Bar Ilan University). The aim of the project is to retell the history of 20th century genetics, centered on the genome rather than the gene.

The ideal candidate will have prior experience in History of Biology as well as relevant education in Biology. However, we are happy to talk to applicants interested in the project even if they lack such experience, especially if they have deep knowledge of contemporary genetics.

Language skills: Knowledge of German and/or Russian would be useful for specific parts of the project, but is not required.
