## Undergraduate Students and Enrollments

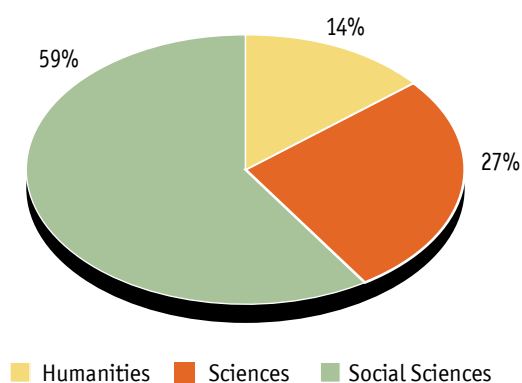
This year, 44,447 students were enrolled in undergraduate courses. OUI students register each semester for individual courses, rather than for fields of study.<sup>1</sup> "Course enrollments" are calculated per course and not per student.

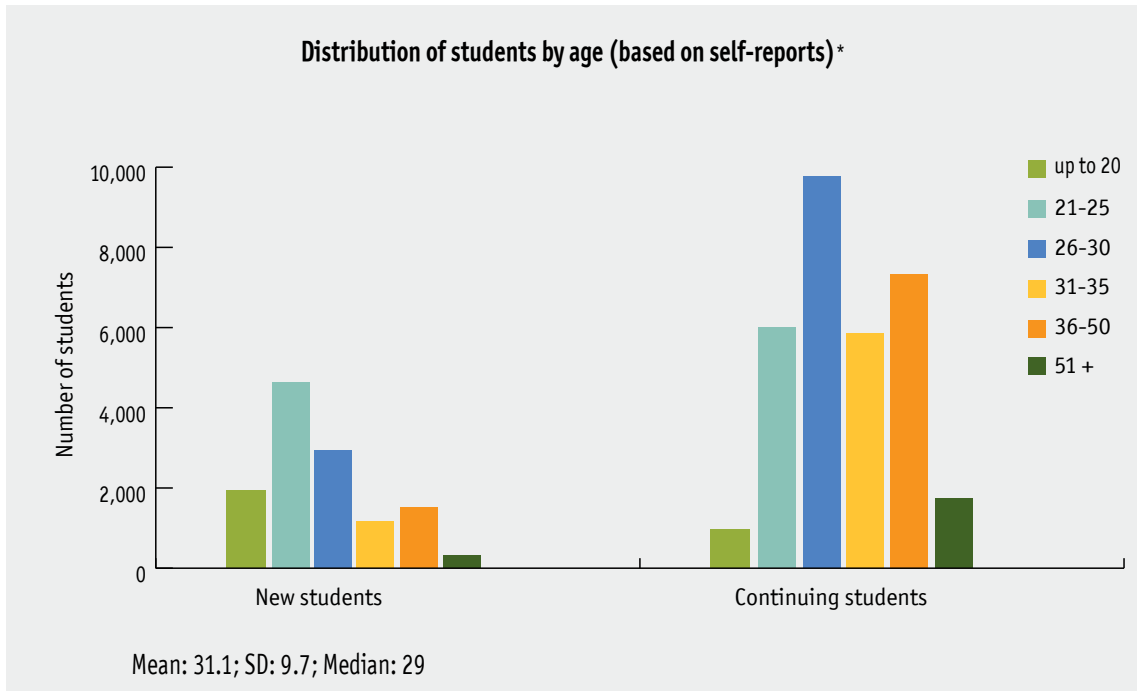
