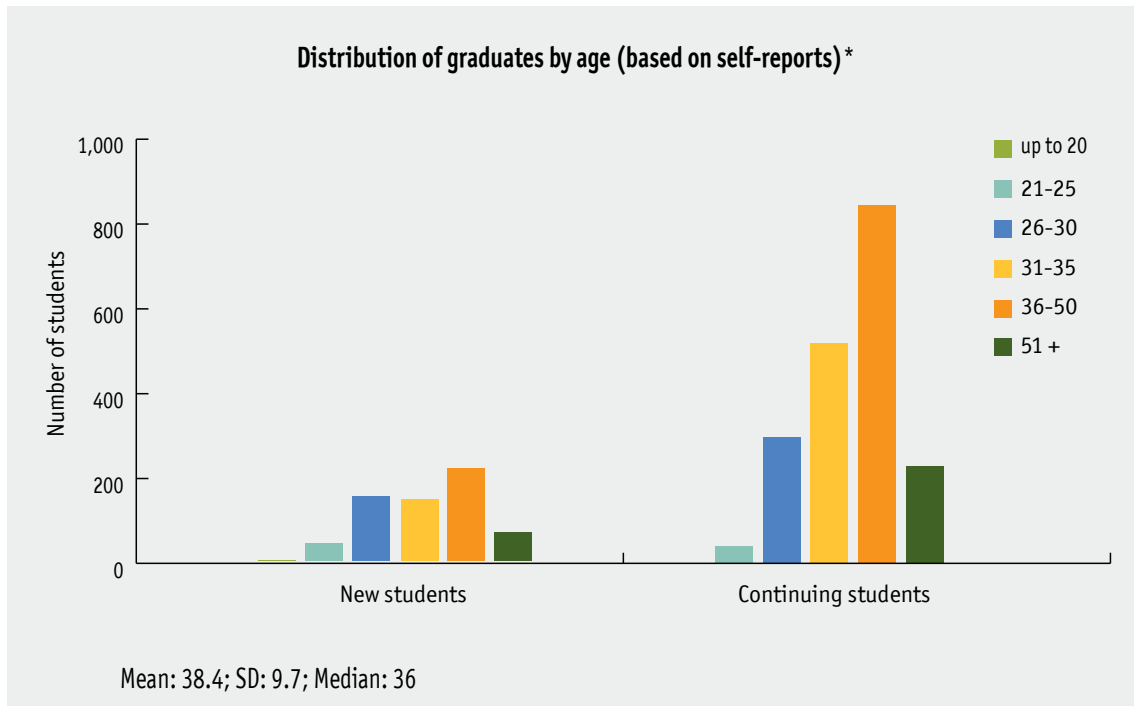
Graduate Students and Enrollments

This year, 2,529 students¹ were enrolled in master's programs. General enrollments stood at 7,457.
