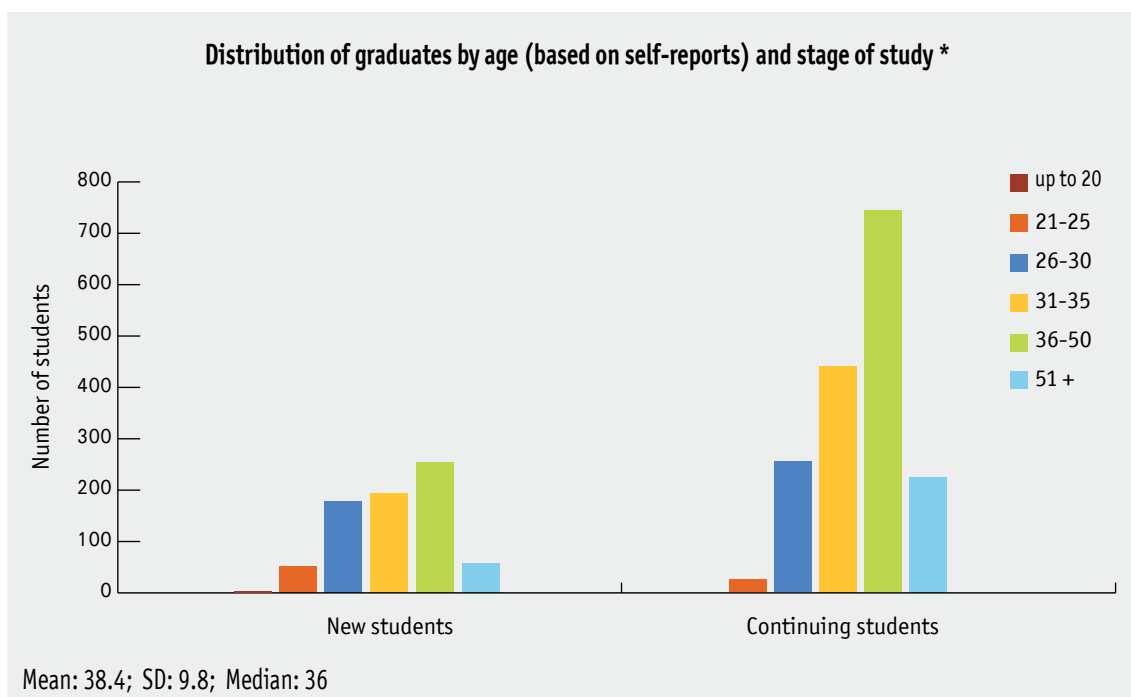
Graduate Students and Enrollments
