

# **Call for Postdoctoral Position in Civil-Military Relations**

# **Overview:**

The Open University Institute for the Study of Civil-Military Relations invites applicants for a postdoctoral research position in the field of civil-military relations. This position is designed for recent PhD graduates (up to 5 years since thesis approval) who are non-Israeli citizens seeking to deepen their research and academic experience in this critical area of study. We strongly encourage proposals that adopt a comparative approach to civil-military relations across different countries and regions.

# **Responsibilities:**

- Conduct independent research on civil-military relations, focusing on contemporary issues and case studies.
- Collaborate with institute members on ongoing research projects.
- Publish research findings in peer-reviewed journals and present them at academic conferences.

# **Qualifications:**

- A Ph.D. in Political Science, International Relations, Sociology, Public Policy, or a closely related field, awarded within the last five years.
- A strong research background in civil-military relations, demonstrated through publications and presentations.
- Proficiency in qualitative and/or quantitative research methods.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills in English.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.

# **Funding:**

The scholarship amount is **100,000 NIS for one year** in addition to flight tickets and hotel accommodation for the first week of stay.

Interested candidates should submit the following documents:

- 1. A cover letter outlining their research interests and how they align with the position.
- 2. A detailed curriculum vitae (CV).
- 3. A research proposal (2-3 pages) for the postdoctoral period, emphasizing any comparative research components.
- 4. Two samples of academic writing (published or unpublished).
- 5. Contact information for two academic references.
